## Current COPD Studies

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**Title:** A one year study to test an inhaled steroid/ beta agonist combination with the inhaled beta agonist alone on the annual rate of exacerbations in subjects with Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD).

**Sponsor:** GlaxoSmithKline (GSK)

**Trial Status:** Phase 3 study, Open for enrollment

**Trial Investigators:** All Nebraska Pulmonary Specialties physicians are participating.

**What is involved in the Study?** The study lasts for 57 weeks. Plan to make at least 11 visits to the clinic. You will also receive reminder phone calls throughout the study and one follow-up phone call after finishing the study drug. In addition to the study drug and rescue inhaler, you will also receive breathing tests, ecgs and lab tests at no cost to you during your participation. A daily diary will need to be completed by each participant.

### Who is eligible to Participate?

- COPD patients with a history of at least one exacerbation in the past year
- Current or past smoker with at least a 10 pack-year history
- Spirometry testing will be done to confirm severity of COPD diagnosis
- No current diagnosis of asthma or other respiratory disorders
- No peptic ulcer disease
- Other criteria will be assessed prior to enrollment.

**Minimum Age:** 40

**Placebo:** There is no placebo (sugar pill) group for this study.

**Compensation:** You will be compensated for your time.
